- HerMin Textile Co., Ltd. was founded in 1976, an era of Taiwan's economic transformation and the export market started to flourish. HerMin focused on the production of its specialty of woven plaid fabric using natural fiber - cotton.
- Evolving with time, new fibers were added and well accepted by consumers due to their multi-function features in comfort, refinement and style. To appeal to a wider audience, HerMin Textile Museum was born in 2014. Here we will be inspired by the world of cotton and textiles.










Places to Visit
